

About our new motto and crest

We welcome Year 11 students from 2025 and these preparations have provided the opportunity to renew our new name and visual identity.

The simplicity of the school's new 'Faith Hope Love' motto crystallises the essence of the school and reflects the spirit of the school community.

The design elements that represent these values in our crest take inspiration from the motto and the Catholic Identity that has been formed.

The new visual identity is bold, confident and contemporary. It distinguishes our school community, honouring the past and providing a fresh look for our future.



FAITH: We believe in one God, who eternally exists as three distinct Persons in one communion – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

The three lines of the cross in our crest represent this belief in the Trinity.



HOPE: The star represents the light of hope of salvation and guides our educational path.



LOVE: Our love for others, of our land and care of creation. Love allows us to grow and thrive.

The three gum leaves, local to our area and a further design nod to the Trinity, represent our community of staff, students and families.



LAND: The cross sits atop a path, indicating our connection to the land on which we learn and a sense of place for our community. The path also symbolises the many journeys of our students, families and staff at our school.



SHAPE: The shape of the crest is also inspired by Trinitarian iconography with three curved sides.

The new crest retains a clear link to the heritage and history of the school and preserves the star found in the previous St Pius X crest, acknowledging our past and representing the light of hope of salvation and guiding the educational path of our school community.

Our colours of blue, red and gold were chosen as they often represent the Trinity.

With Faith, Hope and Love our students, families and staff embark on a new chapter of our history as we become **Trinity Catholic College** in 2025.
